Re: CCA s. 22 Notice and Amendment of Long-Term Care Home Service Accountability Agreement (“Amendment Letter”)

The *Connecting Care Act, 2019* (“CCA”) requires Ontario Health (“OH”) to notify a health service provider when OH proposes to enter into, or amend, a service accountability agreement with that health service provider.

OH hereby gives notice and advises Extendicare (Canada) Inc. in respect of Extendicare London, Extendicare Port Stanley and Extendicare St. Catharines (the “HSP”) of OH’s proposal to amend the Long-Term Care Home Service Accountability Agreement (as described in the CCA) currently in effect between OH and the HSP (the “SAA”).

Subject to the HSP’s acceptance of this Amendment Letter, the SAA will be amended with effect on July 1, 2025, as set out below. All other terms and conditions of the SAA will remain in full force and effect.

The terms and conditions in the SAA are amended as follows:

- 1) The new Licence (2173-L02) for 170 long-term care beds has been issued for Extendicare London, effective July 1, 2025, and expires on June 30, 2030.
- 2) The new Licence (2669-L02) for 60 long-term care beds has been issued for Extendicare Port Stanley, effective July 1, 2025, and expires on June 30, 2030.
- 3) The new Licence (2321-L02) for 152 long-term care beds has been issued for Extendicare St. Catharines, effective July 1, 2025, and expires on June 30, 2030.
- 4) The new Temporary Licence (2321-T04) for 1 long-term care bed has been issued for Extendicare St. Catharines, effective July 1, 2025, and expires on March 31, 2026.
- 5) Schedule A has been amended to reflect these changes.

Unless otherwise defined in this Amendment Letter, all capitalized terms used in this letter have the meanings set out in the SAA.

Please indicate the HSP's acceptance and agreement to the amendments described in this Amendment Letter by signing below and returning the signed version of this entire letter via email to OH-West-Reports@ontariohealth.ca **within 10 business days upon receipt of this letter.**

The HSP and OH agree that this Amendment Letter may be validly executed electronically, and that their respective electronic signature is the legal equivalent of a manual signature.


