**Re: CCA s. 22 Notice and Extension of Long-Term Care Home Service Accountability Agreement – Multi-Home (“Extending Letter”)**

The Connecting Care Act, 2019 (“CCA”) requires Ontario Health (“OH”) to notify a health service provider when OH proposes to enter into, or amend, a service accountability agreement with that health service provider.

OH hereby gives notice and advises Extendicare (Canada) Inc. in respect to Extendicare Hamilton, Extendicare London, Extendicare Port Stanley, Extendicare Southwood Lakes, Extendicare St. Catharines and Extendicare Tecumseh (each “HSP”) of OH’s proposal to amend each long-term care home service accountability agreement – multi-home (as described in the CCA) currently in effect between OH and the HSP (each “SAA”). Subject to the HSP’s acceptance of this Extending Letter, each SAA will be amended with effect on March 31, 2025 as set out below. All other terms and conditions of each SAA will remain in full force and effect.

The terms and conditions in each SAA are amended as follows:

- 1) **Term** – In section 2.1, “March 31, 2025” is deleted and replaced by “March 31, 2026”.
- 2) **Schedules** – The Schedules in effect on March 31, 2025 shall remain in effect until March 31, 2026, or until such other time as may be agreed to in writing by OH and the HSP.

Unless otherwise defined in this letter, all capitalized terms used in this letter have the meanings set out in each SAA.





- 1) **Term** – In section 2.1, “March 31, 2026” is deleted and replaced by “March 31, 2027”.
- 2) **RAI MDS**
  - a. In Section 1.1, the definition of “**RAI MDS Tools**” is deleted and replaced with ““**Long-Term Care Facilities Tools**” or “**LTCF Tools**” means the standardized Long-Term Care Facilities Data Set, the Long-Term Care Facilities User Manual, and the Long-Term Care Facilities Practice Requirements, as the same may be amended from time to time.”
  - b. All references to “RAI MDS” are deleted and replaced with “LTCF Data Set”.
  - c. All references to “RAI MDS Tools” are deleted and replaced with “LTCF Tools”.

- d. All references to “RAI MDS Data” are deleted and replaced with “LTCF Data”.
- e. All references to the “Continuing Care Reporting System” (“CCRS”) are deleted and replaced with “Integrated interRAI Reporting System” (“IRRS”).

3) **Schedules** – The Schedules in effect on March 31, 2026 shall remain in effect until March 31, 2027, or until such other time as may be agreed to in writing by OH and the HSP.


